


Grantseeking Activity Increased








Private Foundations were the most frequent funder award source.



Awards vs Applications






Applying for at least three grant awards increased the frequency of winning an award. Applying for at least six grant awards almost ensures winning at least one award.

Larger organizations consistently reported larger award sizes.










Funders released award monies quickly. 70% within 3 months.



Collaboration by Budget


Increases in annual budget size, with the implied increases in staff and infrastructure, influenced collaborative activities.
